

This is what is needed to submit a final report:

1. Final Report is required to be 508 compliant. There is a template on the CCAT website.
2. URL(s) to, and associated descriptive metadata for, any final from the research project. Review your Data Management Plan (DMP) and upload the data to the specified location. You have access to PURR as a team member, which is free data storage (with a persistent handle/DOI)
3. ORCID(s) (unique researcher IDs) for all project investigators, contributors, and publication author(s) - not just the final reports. It's ok if a student doesn't have one, but anyone that does, needs to be reported.
4. Outputs: PDFs and URLs for any resulting publications (other than the final reports above). This should be a bullet list with a description of the output. Start with Type (conference paper, journal article, etc.); followed by the author, title, date, publication, or whatever is relevant to that output; and then the URL - with the PDF attached.
5. Outcomes: document the project outcomes resulting from the research project. Please have this written and formatted in a professional manner. Can be a summary from the final report but should be what has been included in the semi-annual reports to date. Keep these as short as possible - just a couple of sentences. We don't want you to write another paper!
6. Impacts: document the project impacts. Please have this written and formatted in a professional manner. Can be a summary from the final report but should be what has been included in the semi-annual reports to date. Keep these as short as possible. Same as above.
